Appointments are available to the following BCSS committees:

**COACHING DEVELOPMENT (up to 3 people):** *Spirit of Coaching Conference Series, NCCP Hosting Program, Coaches' Recognition Program, Coach's Code of Conduct recommendations*

**COMPETITIVE STANDARDS (up to 3 people):** (formerly the Championship Standards Committee) *championship standards, addition of new sports, competitive regulations such as seasons of play, tiering, age group competition.*

**DISCIPLINARY APPEALS COMMITTEE:** *appeal committee for violations of codes of conduct complaints filed under 8.4.1 and 8.4.2, or appeals of the BCSS Harassment policy. 2 reps per zone required.*

**REGISTRATION APPEALS COMMITTEE (up to 6 people):** *decisions on maintaining, reducing or waiving fines for late Player Registration Forms*

**SCHOLARSHIPS & AWARDS COMMITTEE (3 people):** *program outline and selection of recipients for the annual BCSS Scholarships and various awards.*

**Administrators Committee (up to 8 people):** *to address issues that are of concern to the school administration globally and to offer suggestions and/or recommendations to the Board of Directors.*

**Rules and Regulations Committee (up to 6 people):** *to review and provide recommendations annually on changes or modifications to the competitive rules and regulations of the organization.*

**Jury of Appeal (up to 6 people):** *to hear all second level student athlete appeals and to determine overall eligibility based on the submission of additional information. This level of appeal is final and binding.*
