<p>Book your practice round by phoning: <b>The Springs Course - Radium Resort 250-347-6200</b></p> <p>To ensure you and your players are included in the practice round it is imperative for you to contact the course and inform them of the number of spots you require (i.e. 5 players and 2 coaches = 7 spots). Do not ask them for 2 tee times. They want to know the exact "number of bodies" so they can be sure every group goes off as a foursome and everyone gets a chance to play.</p> <p><i>It may also mean you might have one or two people from another school joining you, so please make your players aware.</i></p> <p><b>Teams that have a second coach playing in the practice round or in the draw will be charged \$ 28.00 per round. Cheques are payable to The Springs Course - Radium Resort</b></p>	

- ❖ The dress and no tobacco code as outlined in our constitution will be in effect during the practice round and both competitive rounds. The executive will instruct the pro to forbid play to any team member who fails to comply. The dress code will be strictly enforced for the duration of the Tournament. Any player failing to comply with section XII of the rules and regulations will not be permitted on the course. (**One notable exception to this will be**, players may substitute an alternate, acceptable golf shirt, **for the practice round only**, as the proper shirt will be required at dinner and the two competitive rounds.)
- ❖ The golf course is charging **\$28.00 (incl. taxes)** per person per round, coaches included, to offset a portion of the revenue they will lose over the three days we are there.
- ❖ **Golf Carts:** Coaches please inform your players they are not permitted to use motorized golf carts at any time on the course without the express permission of the executive.

## PERTINENT TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

- ❖ Please ensure your golfers use only the practice facilities designated by the host pros. (Check with them for any restrictions.)
- ❖ The "AA" golf Executive and the Tournament Chairmen have worked hard to provide for you and your team, and we cannot stress enough the importance that all competitors maintain the high caliber of conduct and sportsmanship this association expects.
- ❖ **RULES:** The members of your team are expected to be knowledgeable of, and comply with, the rules of the game. We have had to disqualify schools in past years for breaches of those rules. So please inform your players if they are in doubt as to what to do, and there is not an official near them, and:

### **BEFORE THEY PLAY ANY SHOT: THEY ARE TO:**

1. Inform their marker of what they intend to do, and which ball they wish to count and only then,
2. Play the original ball as it lies, and then play the provisional ball.
3. Play both balls until they are holed out.
4. Get a ruling before the score card is signed.

-- **"This must be done in exactly this order"** --

- ❖ **DRESS CODE and DEPARTMENT:**
  - The dress code will be strictly enforced for the duration of the Championship, with the exception of the practice round on Sunday where an alternate golf shirt may be worn.
  - **NO PLAYER WILL BE ALLOWED TO TEE OFF WHO FAILS TO COMPLY WITH SECTION XII OF THE RULES AND REGULATIONS RELATING TO ACCEPTABLE DRESS, AND ALL COMPETITORS ARE TO DRESS IN THEIR TEAM UNIFORMS FOR THE BANQUET MONDAY EVENING.**

❖ **FINAL WORD:**

- Regardless of whether you play a practice round on that day or not, or where you are on the course, your team must be in attendance for the team pictures and registration on Sunday
- I am sure by this letter you can appreciate a great deal of time and preparation has gone into the planning to make this a successful, enjoyable, and problem-free Provincial Championship. We simply request you abide by the decisions that the Tournament Committee has made that have the best interest of all competing teams in mind.

Congratulations on earning the right to represent your Zone in this year's Championships. We look forward to seeing you in Radium.

If you have attended a Provincial Golf Championship in the past few years, you are aware we have all coaches **PAY THE REGISTRAR DIRECTLY** for all rounds of golf each school pays. We will issue you a receipt, and in turn write a cheque for the total green fees owing to the course. It makes the task easier for everyone concerned.

**It is important that all coaches understand we have a contract with the golf courses for a minimum of 18 rounds of golf per school. (5 players and a coach for 3 days) If you do not make it to the practice round on Sunday you are still required to pay the full amount which is \$396.00 – NO EXCEPTIONS.**

The green fee cheque must be paid at the registration on Sunday. A cheque for \$396 payable to Radium Resort. If you have an additional person (an extra coach or parent in addition to the 5 team members and official coach) the cost per round of golf will be \$28.00. So, if your assistant coach wants to play only the practice round, you would add \$28 to the \$396. If a parent wanted to play all three rounds you would add \$84 to the \$396.
