**ENTRY FEES**

**Entry Fee: \$ 130.00**

The entry fee covers the banquet for the five players and one coach and the post tournament program. Please make this cheque out to the **BCSSGA**.

**Green Fee: \$ 396.00**

This covers the green fees for the five players and one coach for all three days - that is for up to eighteen rounds of golf. Schools that have a second coach playing must pay an additional \$28.00 per round. Please make this cheque payable to ***The Dunes at Kamloops***.

\* The cost of green fees have been offset by a credit of \$108 for each school from B.C. Lotteries through B.C. School Sports.

1:00 p.m.	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Practice Round. 1:00 p.m. Shotgun Start</b></p> <p>To ensure you and your players are included in the practice round it is imperative for you to contact the course and inform them of the number of spots you require (i.e. 5 players and 2 coaches = 7 spots). Do not ask them for 2 tee times. They want to know the exact "number of bodies" so they can be sure every group goes off as a foursome and everyone gets a chance to play.</p> <p><i>It may also mean you might have one or two people from other schools joining you, so please make your players aware.</i> The shotgun start will enable everyone to finish in time for the SKILLS COMPETITION which will start at 6:00. Teams that have a second coach playing in the practice round or in the draw will be charged \$ 28.00 per round. Cheques are payable to The Dunes at Kamloops</p>
6:00 p.m.	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Skills Competition</b></p> <p>This competition will provide five (5) skills events held prior to the banquet. Registration sheet attached. Please place your players in the event they, or you choose, and e-mail the form to the number indicated. <b>Competitors must be in uniform for the skills competition.</b></p>
7:15 p.m.	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Banquet at The Dunes at Kamloops.</b></p> <p>All teams must be in attendance, <b>and in their school golf uniform.</b> All pertinent information relating to the tournament, local rules, etc. will be discussed at the dinner.</p>

Please note: If you are planning to get to Kamloops and play an additional practice round on the Sunday, be sure to contact the pro-shop at the above number well in advance to see if they can accommodate you.

- The dress and no tobacco code as outlined in our constitution will be in effect during the practice round and both competitive rounds. The executive will instruct the pro to forbid play to any team member who fails to comply. The dress code will be strictly enforced for the duration of the Tournament. Any player failing to comply with section XII of the rules and regulations will not be permitted on the course. **(One notable exception to this will be, players may substitute an alternate, acceptable golf shirt, for the practice round only, as the proper shirt will be required at dinner and the two competitive rounds.)**
- The golf course is charging **\$28.00 (incl. taxes)** per person per round, coaches included, to offset a portion of the revenue they will lose over the three days we are there.

## BANQUET INFORMATION

The Banquet will be held at 7:15 p.m. at The Dunes at Kamloops. All teams **MUST** be in attendance and in their **school golf attire.**

**PLACE CARDS** seating your team will be located on the tables indicating where each team is to sit. **WE MUST KNOW THE EXACT NUMBER OF PEOPLE** in your party if you are to sit together. Please tell your players to sit only where their place cards indicate.

Each school will be allotted 6 places at dinner - if you have more than that number i.e. assistant coach or parent/driver, you must inform Bob Matlock A.S.A.P preferably before he leaves for the Championship if that person wishes to join their team for dinner, otherwise they cannot be accommodated in the seating. 9:45 a.m.	The first tee time will be at 9:45am. The person listed as the coach on the entry form will be placed in the draw for the Tuesday round as close to their teams as possible. Other coaches will also be slotted into the draw but will have to play where it is in the best interest of the Tournament. Everyone wishing to play on the Wednesday will be expected to make up their own foursomes this is your opportunity to play with whom you choose, your co-coach or drive and give the names of those in your group to Stan Kusznieryk, before Tuesday evening. This can be done at the banquet, at the golf course, prior to or after the A.G.M., or by calling Stan at his room.

## SCHEDULE FOR WEDNESDAY, JUNE 1 - ROUND TWO

7:30 am.	<b>FINAL ROUND - SHOTGUN START</b> The draw for the final round will be determined by the first day scores and posted at the course prior to the round.
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The first round draw will be made according to our Constitution, done by the Executive, and included in the materials that will be placed at your table at the banquet.

The final round will have teams teeing off all 18 tees according to their first round team scores.

It is possible the course may be open the kitchen at 6:00 a.m. prior to this round, but this will have to be confirmed at the banquet.—be sure to ask about it.

The awards presentation will be conducted immediately following the 2<sup>nd</sup> round and we encourage all participants to remain for these ceremonies. Play-offs for the individual and team championship will be conducted, if necessary, prior to the awards presentation.

Each year, in the past, the female players have chosen to stay with each other to help offset costs, but also to make new friends and enjoy their company.

The rooms have been reserved for **Monday, May 30th and Tuesday May 31st ONLY** (If you and your team are planning to come on the Sunday afternoon you will have to make your own arrangements at the hotel for that evening.)

The Hotel has requested that when you know you are going Kamloops, to please contact them with the school name, the names of the players who will be staying together, and yours, to give them time to organize your accommodations. **THIS MUST BE DONE BY MAY 20th.**

## OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Please ensure your golfers use only the practice facilities designated by the host pro. (Check with him for any restrictions.)

- Your executive along with Tournament Chairman, Mike Abraham, have worked hard to provide for you and your team, and we cannot stress enough the importance that all competitors maintain the high calibre of conduct and sportsmanship this association expects.
- We will have BCGA Officials on the course to assist your players with rulings. We are going to be closely monitoring the Pace of Play at this event.
- **Please inform your players that they are not allowed to use power carts at any time.**
- The members of your team are expected to be knowledgeable of, and comply with, the rules of the game. We have had to disqualify players and schools in past years for breaches of those rules.

Please, inform your players if they are in doubt as to what to do, and there is not an official near them, **THAT BEFORE THEY PLAY ANY SHOT, THEY MUST:**

1. Inform their marker of what they intend to do, and which ball they wish to count, and only then.
2. Play the original ball as it lies, and then play the provisional ball after taking the relief they think they are entitled to.
3. Play both balls until they are holed out
4. Get a ruling before the score card is signed, from the tournament committee.

\*\*\*\*\***IT MUST BE DONE IN EXACTLY THIS ORDER**\*\*\*\*\*

Please note that the dress code will be strictly enforced for the duration of the Championship, with the exception of the practice round on Monday where an alternate golf shirt may be worn. **NO PLAYER WILL BE ALLOWED TO TEE OFF WHO FAILS TO COMPLY WITH SECTION XII OF THE RULES AND REGULATIONS RELATING TO ACCEPTABLE DRESS, AND ALL COMPETITORS ARE TO DRESS IN THEIR TEAM UNIFORMS FOR THE OPENING BANQUET MONDAY EVENING.**

We have been asked by the director of Golf at the course that as a courtesy to the Golf Club and its members, to please inform your players they are to **remove their hats at the banquet.**

One final note for Monday, regardless of whether you play a practice round on that day or not, or where you are on the course, your team must be in attendance for the 6:00 skills competition, and the 7:15 p.m. banquet.

I am sure by this letter you can appreciate a great deal of time and preparation has gone into the planning to make this a successful, enjoyable, and problem-free Provincial Championship.
