Application Deadline – Monday, May 2nd, 2011

The B.C. High School Boys Volleyball Commission is pleased to once again be offering scholarships. There will be two scholarships with a value of \$400.00 - \$500.00 each.

Scholarship Application Rules and Regulations

1. Scholarships shall be provided by the BCHSBVA to any successful applicant of a team affiliated with the BCHSBVA.
2. Scholarships shall be awarded to students proceeding from grade 12 to any accredited Canadian university or college.
3. Candidates must complete the application form in full and provide all required information, documents, and letters in order for their application to be considered.
4. A candidate must have a proficiency in indoor volleyball.
5. A candidate must demonstrate good citizenship, character, and leadership.
6. A candidate must have a minimum C+ average in his marks or the capability of being accepted by the post-secondary institution of his choice. Incl. Eng 12 & 2 prov exam course marks (final or most up to date interim grade)
7. The following must accompany the application:
 - a) a letter from the principal certifying the candidate's scholarship, character and citizenship
 - b) a letter from the coach indicating the candidate's character, leadership, and, in particular, volleyball ability.
 - c) a transcript of the student's marks or a photocopy of the Permanent Record Card. If neither is available, a typed copy of the Permanent Record Card verified by the principal's signature will be accepted.
 - d) marks from all of this year's reporting periods to the end of April must be included.
 - e) a copy of your schedule and results from the past high school season.
 - f) two recent photographs (head and shoulder shots).

Note: It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure that all required information (photos, documents, and letters) are enclosed with the application. Please mail your completed application package to:
