Scholarship Application Guidelines

- The B.C. Secondary Schools Badminton Association offers scholarships to two participants in this year's Tournament and two that did not qualify for the Tournament.
- They will be distributed to one boy and one girl in each category.
- The value of these Scholarships will be determined by funds available but will generally be \$200.00 each.
- Only students graduating will be eligible to apply.
- The funds will be paid out when proof of registration at a Post Secondary Institution is submitted to the Scholarship Committee of the Association.
- These scholarships will be valid for a term of two (2) years past there being awarded.
- Each school may nominate one boy and one girl and each application must be forwarded with the following information in order to be considered:

For Inclusion:

1. Scholarship – The academic standing of all subjects taken in Grade 11 plus the marks on the most recent report card.
2. Badminton – A summary of their contribution to the team. (Usually by coach)
3. Citizenship – A character reference from two staff members.
4. Service – Any service work the student has done in the School or Community.
5. Need – Does the candidate have a need for financial support? This should be included in the applicant's personal letter as to their suitability.
