BCSS Patners with Dr. Martin Camiré on Mental Health Study

Mental health concerns everyone, especially those of us working with young student-athletes. BCSS is proud to be partnering with Dr. Martin Camire and his team at the University of Ottawa on their mental health in sport study. Dr. Camire is an Associate Professor at U Ottawa in the School of Human Kinetics. Through his research, Dr. Camire is interested in examining how positive youth development can be facilitated through the context of sport. BCSS has worked with Dr. Camire previously as he is one of the leading reserachers on educational athletics in Canada. The goal of this particular study is to better understand the link between adolescents participating in sport and their mental health. The study will take place over the course of five years, following senior student-athletes from adolescence into young adulthood through a series of annual surveys. The research team is currently looking for grade 11 and 12 student-athletes from across Canada to participate in the study. At the end of each year, participants will be entered into a draw to win one of several Amazon gift cards. We ask that you share this important information with your students so we can all better understand the connections between sport and mental health. 2019-2020 BCSS AWARDS

Teacher, Athletic Directors, Administrators and Commissioners! Do you know someone in your local school community who goes above and beyond with your sports programs? Start thinking about those who have made a significant difference to high school sport this season and nominate them for one of the following BC School Sports Awards.

Honor Award

- Must have been involved as a coach/sponsor at the school level
- Must have served administratively on at least two of the following: Executive of a Local Association, Executive of a Sport Commission or member of a Standing Committee
 - Must have served at least one full 2 year term as a member of the BCSS Board of Directors
 - Must be, or have been, a teacher or administrator
 - Must not currently be a member of the BCSS Board of Directors

Merit Award

- Must have been involved as a coach/sponsor, administrator or official at the school level
- Must have served administratively on at least one of the following: Executive of a Local Association; Executive of a Sport Commission; member of a Standing Committee; member of the BCSS Board of Directors
 - Must not currently be a member of the BCSS Board of Directors.

Coach of the Year (Male & Female)

- Must have been actively involved in coaching high school athletics for a minimum of ten years
 - Consistently promotes the philosophy of fair play and sportsmanship
 - Must be, or have been, a teacher or school administrator
 - Must not currently be a member of the BCSS Board of Directors

Outstanding School

To recognize a school whose special commitment to improving the lives of its students and staff through athletics, intramurals, leadership and public service has contributed significantly to the welfare of school athletics in its local community and within the province.

Sanctioning

Hosting or Travelling to an Event

Competition between two or more BCSS member schools is automatically sanctioned. When you are travelling to or hosting an event or exhibition game with an out of province team sanctioning is required. Complete the sanctioning form on the website at least 30 days in advance of the event or fines will apply.

Third Party Event Sanctioning

If your school wishes to attend an event that is not hosted by a member school (eg: university, club, community etc.) please ensure the event has been sanctioned by BCSS before attending. There is a list of BCSS third party sanctioned events on the BCSS homepage.

2019-2020 Scholarship Information

BCSS will once again be offering several scholarships to our deserving student-athletes. Applications are now open, the deadline for submitting applications is May 4th 2020. Check out the scholarships being offered for the 2019-2020 school year!

Dave Gifford Memorial Scholarships and Zone Scholarships

Dave Gifford was a BCSS Director from 1988-90, and received the BCSS Honour Award in 1992. He was a teacher and Administrator in Vancouver, and died in 1992. In his honour the Dave Gifford Memorial Scholarship was created. The BCSS Zone Scholarships are awarded to one male and one female student in each of our seven BCSS zones. Applicants must have competed in at least 1 BCSS approved sport during grade 12 for the Zone Scholarship, and at least 2 BCSS approved sports for the Dave Gifford Memorial Scholarship.

Applicants must have competed in at least 1 BCSS approved sport during grade 12 (2 for Dave Gifford Memorial Scholarship). To qualify for the Dave Gifford or Zone Scholarship, the applicant must:

- Be enrolled in and have participated at a BCSS Member School
- Be graduating this year and will be entering their first year of full-time studies in a Canadian University or College.
- Have demonstrated exceptional athletic achievement in a BCSS activity and, have a minimum grade percentage of 75%
- Have demonstrated outstanding service and leadership in school and/or community.
- Be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident or person to whom refugee protection has been confirmed under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act

Bert and Greta Quartermaine Badminton Scholarship

The Bert & Greta Quartermaine Badminton Scholarship fund is provided by Bert & Greta Quartermaine, and is dedicated to assisting worthy BC School Sports student-athletes competing in badminton at the high school level in their desire to attend an accredited Canadian post-secondary school.

The Bert & Greta Quartermaine Badminton Scholarship rewards excellence in both scholastic and athletic pursuits. The successful applicants will be student-athletes who have balanced their achievements as badminton athletes with significant success as leaders and contributors to their community.

To qualify for the Bert & Greta Quartermaine Scholarship, the applicant must:

- Have played badminton for a BC School Sports member school
- Be graduating this year and will be entering their first year of full-time studies in a Canadian University or College.
- Demonstrate leadership and volunteer-ism within their school or community
- Be a Canadian citizen, permanent resident or person to whom refugee protection has been confirmed under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act

BC Dairy Association Scholarship

BC Dairy Association is dedicated to assisting worthy student-athletes in their desire to attend an accredited Canadian University or College by sponsoring this year's BC Dairy Association Scholarship. The BC Dairy Association Scholarship rewards student-athletes who exemplify school spirit, practice a healthy lifestyle and engage with their community.

To qualify for the BC Dairy Association Scholarship, the applicant must:

- Have competed in their grade 12 year in the BCSS sports of:
 - Boys Soccer
 - Girls Soccer
 - Boys Volleyball
- Be graduating this year and will be entering their first year of full-time studies in a Canadian University or College
- Have demonstrated school spirit, a healthy lifestyle, and community involvement.
