2017 - 2018 Member School Tiering Report

Tiering Appeals for the 2017-2018 School Year must be submitted by October 1, 2017

The BCSS membership overwhelmingly passed Motion #11 (Number Calculation for all Tiering Classifications) at the 2017 AGM. The policy adds clarification on how competitive tiers for sports will be calculated moving forward. Starting in the 2017-2018 school year, tiering numbers will be determined by the total number of Grade 11, Grade 12 and Secondary Ungraded (SU) students in your school. As is the same as previous years the number of Grade 10, Grade 11 and SU students as reported on the

September 30, 2016 1701 report to the Ministry of Education will be used for the 2017-2018 tiering numbers.

We have already recieved some concern from schools and districts relative to their use of SU students and wishing to reclassify them for tiering purposes. At the direction of the Board of Directors, and with fairness and transparancy as the goal,



the Board will allow tiering appeals on the basis of SU students for one year only. The rationale for this decision is that the schools and districts were not aware of the impact of their reporting when they submitted numbers.
