Sport on the Move Travel Grant

The 2016-17 Sport on the Move program in partnership with ViaSport supported 2136 students from 128 unique schools.

The Province of British Columbia's Sport on the Move travel grant program is supported through the Ministry of Community, Sport and Cultural Development and administered jointly by ViaSport and BC School Sports. The program is designed to offer financial assistance to schools traveling 350 km or more (one way), and/or taken a ferry to travel to their respective BC School Sports provincial championship.

New for the 2016-2017 school year was the "opt-in" approach to the grant whereby schools needed to confirm their contact information and provide electronic banking information in order to be considered for funding. Overall, we at ViaSport believe this approach was extremely successful and are pleased with the implementation. As a result of the opt-in system, administration time was greatly reduced and in many cases, schools were able to receive their allotted funding within a week of the conclusion of each championship season. We were also successful in eliminating much of the confusion that arose from cheques being distributed and administrators having little idea where they came from or for what they were intended.

In 2016-2017 the average payout per supported student athlete was \$52.04 while the average school received \$1,250.

We will be sending out a notice regarding the 2017-2018 Sport on the Move program and look forward to continuing with the program.

Athlete Approvals

When students are being entered in STARS, remember they are subject to a **TWO business day** approval period. Only grade 8 students with a 2004 birth year and 2017 grade 8 entry date are automatically approved with the bulk upload.

*Note if grade 8 students are entered manually (not in bulk upload) they are also subject to the TWO day approval period.
