

#### Introduction

All registration for competition in BCSS approved sports is done through the on-line registration system (STARS - STudent Athlete Registration System) on the BCSS website. Member schools must register their schools, teams and athletes by the policy deadlines. BCSS and the 19 Sport Commissions oversee 162 zone playoffs and 54 provincial championships each year.


As a Sports Commissioner, you have access to information about schools, students, and teams related to your sport (Example: Boys Senior AAA Football).




### Coach Export

To view all coaches registered for a specific sport, click "Coach Export" on the top left corner. This will generate an excel spreadsheet with a list of information including:

- School Name
- First and Last name
- Email
- Coach Type (SD Employee, Teacher or Community Coach)
- Fax
- Team
- Work Phone
- Home Phone






### **CSV Exports**

On the top left corner, select "CSV" Exports to view information about Student Participation, Team Registration and Student Participation History.




Click "CSV Exports", which will bring you to a page with different options for excel spreadsheets:

- Student Participation Displays the number of students registered in your sport
  - Select the year that you want to view (beginning from 2008 to the present).
  - Students per zone or athletic association? (No, Athletic Association, or Regional Zone).
- Team Registration Displays the number of teams registered in your sport
  - Select the year that you want to view (beginning from 2008 to the present).
  - Students per zone or athletic association? (No, Athletic Association, or Regional Zone).
- Student Participation History Displays the number of students for your sport historically




## **BCSS Enrolment Export**

To view information about enrollment in your sport, select "BCSS Enrolment Export" on the top left corner of the main webpage.




This will generate an excel spreadsheet contacting information about the number of students registered through BCSS. The spreadsheet will list:

- School Name
- Type of Students (Boys, Girls or Total)
- Number of Grade 8
- Number of Grade 9
- Number of Grade 10
- Number of Ungraded Jr. (Students who do not clearly belong to one grade)
- Number of Grade 11
- Number of Grade 12
- Number of Ungraded Sr. (Students who do not clearly belong to one grade)
- Number of Total Seniors



### List of Schools

The main webpage displays a list of all the schools for a specific sport and zone. You can select "View" to the right of a school to view more information about that school.



\*Note: When searching for a school, type out the name partially in case there are any errors or duplicates when inputting information.

When you select "View" you will be able to see information describing the team. This includes:

- Athletic Director Name
- Athletic Director Email
- Athletic Association
- Regional Zone
- Team Name
- Address
- School Phone Number
- List of all team members and grades
- Head Coach

- Registration Details
  - Declare Team Deadline
  - Minimum # of Students
  - Minimum # of StudentsDeadline
  - Final Deadline
  - Whether this team be your provincial representative
  - Whether it is a joint team

Under the title (Example: "Boys Senior Football Team"), there is an option to **create a PDF** of the team roster. Select "Generate PDF" to download the team's roster.

#### Search for Schools

You can search for a specific school on the main webpage. Type a school name in the search bar or use the filters such as:

- Sport category (Grade 8, 9, Junior or Senior).
- Gender (Male, Female, Co-ed, or Open).
- Minimum # met (Complete, Incomplete, or Both).
  - This indicates teams that have the minimum number of students needed on a team.
    For example, track and field needs a minimum of 1 student on the team whereas basketball needs a minimum of 5.
- Classification (A, AA, AAA, or AAAA).
- Regional Zone
  - Zone A Kootenays
  - Zone B Okanagan
  - Zone C North Central District
  - Zone D Northwest Zone
  - Zone E Vancouver Island
  - o Zone F Lower Mainland
  - Zone G Fraser Valley
