Natalie Cavallin

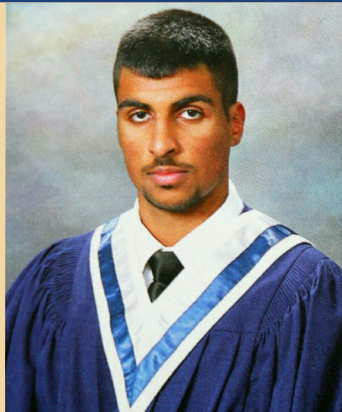
Claremont Secondary
