4. Business Arising from the Minutes

i) May general meeting –

A number of motions were up for vote at this meeting including the lengthening of the boys basketball season and the introduction of junior provincials. None of the motions were able to be put to a vote when the quorum at the meeting was lost in the middle of the meeting.

ii) October – BCSS Commissioners Meeting

At the Commissioners and Athletic Directors meeting a number of initiatives from BCSS were introduced. BCSS will fund a medical person for all provincial championships. Also, webcasting equipment is available for provincial championships. Dave Braun is our new Director of Sport who assists us with BCSS items.

iii) Update Rules and Regualtions -

A sub-committee of Marci M, Rhonda T, and Mike W has been formed to review the Rules and Regulations which were last done in 2007. These will be updated and hopefully voted on at a Special Meeting convened at the 2015 Provincial Championships.

6. BCSS Report

- This years grants – \$3000(BCSS), \$4500 (gaming commission) - this is an increase of \$3000 from the previous year

- Basketball wishes to extend season, may run into first week of tennis season

- There is currently Junior provincial in other sports – these are not sanctioned by BCSS, and are usually by invitation only They are seen as being instrumental in growing the sports and increasing participation.

- BCSS has sent out a Travel Survey – we urge all school to fill it out for your provincial championships for 2015 and for 2014, if you have the

data. This will be very helpful in determining financial assistance to those teams who must always travel to the provincial championships. BCSS will be looking into Academy and Sport specific schools to see how their programs fit into the BCSS model.

7. Tennis BC Update

Anne Bees attended the meeting representing Tennis BC.

- We have switched to the Penn Marathon tennis ball to follow the switch by Tennis BC. Anne will investigate a BCSS purchase price for these balls
- Pro D days have been held in gyms which were very successful in introducing tennis to PE curriculum. Anne will look for more opportunities to introduce the game to high schools
- Fortius BC (where BCSS has their office in Burnaby across from the Burnaby tennis courts) has rooms available for teams to stay.
 Marci will investigate a pricing structure for the 2015 provincial championships. There are eating facilities there as well.
- There are tennis coaches available and willing to assist with high school tennis. Anne has developed a list. will connect with Rhonda to distribute to athletic directors and Marci to distribute to zone reps.
- Anne will help with indoor court bookings at provincials as much as she is able. – will meet with ladies league reps to facilitate coordination with them.
- Anne will speak with Burnaby Parks and Recreation to enquire about leaving their bubble up slightly longer so that it would be available for our provincial championships
