### Additional Details

**Warm up:** Please note that Sandpiper does not have a driving range for pre- round warm-ups. There are driving ranges at Bridal Falls, Ledgeview and Chilliwack Golf Course for those wishing to arrange for pre-round warm-ups.

**Banquet:** Banquet tickets are \$45.00 per person, and team tables will hold up to 6 people. While banquet tickets are not mandatory, it is strongly advised that teams participate, as the head rules official, course official and committee chair will address the players and coaches.
