Additional Details

Warm up: Please note that Sandpiper does not have a driving range for pre-round warm-ups. There are driving ranges at Bridal Falls, Ledgeview and Chilliwack Golf Course for those wishing to arrange for pre-round warm-ups.

Banquet: Banquet tickets are \$45.00 per person, and team tables will hold up to 6 people. While banquet tickets are not mandatory, it is strongly advised that teams participate, as the head rules official, course official and committee chair will address the players and coaches. Please indicate on your registration form how many tickets you would like to be invoiced for—we will not be able to add plates after registration forms are submitted.
