- No zone will receive more than 4 berths into the provincial championships.
- If a zone is unable to fill its berths, the berths will not be reallocated.
- Golf is a co-ed sport, there are no gender specific requirements for your roster.

Important Dates

- Team Registration Deadline: **April 10, 2024**
- Zone Declaration/ Intent to compete at Provincials: **May 10, 2024**
- Zone Championship Deadline: **May 22, 2024**
- Tournament Registration Deadline: **May 24, 2024**

STARS Registration

- All student athletes must be registered on your school's STARS roster.
 - Team registration deadline – **April 10, 2024**
 - Roster registration deadline – **April 24, 2024**
 - All athletes representing your school team in competition must be entered on your STARS roster by this date.
 - Athlete registrations submitted after the designated deadline must be added to the official STARS roster by BCSS staff. Late registrations are subject to penalties outlined in the BCSS Handbook.
- Coaches need to be added to your STARS rosters by **April 24th**. Only coaches listed on the STARS roster will be permitted on the field of play and at the coaches' meetings.
 - *All coaches, managers, and assistants listed on school team rosters must complete the Concussion Awareness Training Tool (CATT) for Coaches. CATT certification is valid for two years - cattonline.com.* Athletic Directors are responsible for ensuring all coaches have completed the CATT certification prior to engaging in any competition.
 - Please ensure all coach information (email and cell #) is correct. You can easily modify the information in STARS by accessing the coach's profile.

Team Registration

Zone reps/zone tournament chairs must send the school and coach contact information of their qualifying team to:

- BCSS Manager of Sport & Events, Julie Stevens via email jstevens@bcschoolsports.ca by **May 23**.

Coaches will be sent a registration form to be completed and submitted by **May 24th**.

If a team is registered for the Provincial Championship and subsequently withdraws after **May 24**, the zone may be subject to sanctions.

Tournament Details

The Championships will consist of a two (2) day event, with 18-holes being played each day. The team with the lowest total score for the 36 holes shall be crowned Provincial Champions.

Foursomes:

- No two players representing the same school shall be in the same foursome.

- **Round 1:** Golfers will be placed according to team placement and seeding (eg: Number 1 golfers play together).
- **Round 2:** Golfers will be placed according to their first day team totals with #1 golfers playing with each other.

Tee Times:

- One coach from each school will be included on the tee sheet on Day 1 of the competition and will tee off in front of or behind their team.
 - Other coaches with that team will be included where they can fit into the draw.
- Only student-athletes are allowed to play on the 2nd day of the championship.
 - No Coaches or other guests are permitted to participate without permission of the tournament director or BC School Sports.
- Tee times for the 2nd round should be an early morning shot gun start to allow time for travel.

Banquet: An optional tournament dinner will be held:

- **Date:** June 4th

- **Time:** 5:30-7:00pm
- **Location:** Arbutus Ridge Golf Course Dining Room
- **Cost:** TBC
- **Attire:** School Team Golf Shirt & Bottoms
- **Registration:** Will be included in the coach registration form. Please determine the number of athletes & coaches attending.
 - Each school is allotted 7 tickets at dinner. Include coaches and chaperones during registration. (Additional tickets cannot be purchased)
 - Schools will be invoiced for cost for the banquet tickets

Dress Code: A dress code will be strictly enforced for the duration of the tournament. Any player failing to comply with section 1085.0 of the BC School Sports Handbook will not be permitted on the course.

- The one exception to this is players may substitute an alternate, acceptable golf shirt, for the practice round only, as the proper shirt will be required at dinner and the two competitive rounds. The tournament director will instruct the Pro to deny play to any team member who fails to comply.

Uniforms: All teams attending Championships must have jerseys/shirts of matching colour and design. Matching shorts are recommended but not required.

- Corporate logos are restricted to a maximum of two logos, and each logo should not exceed the dimensions of a credit card.

Skills Competition: The skills contest is scheduled immediately following the banquet. Each school selects one student-athlete for each of the 5 skills, no player can enter more than one contest:

- long drive,
- putting,
- 20-yard chip,
- sand chip and
- 150-yard KP.

The skills entry form is included in the Team Registration form sent to coaches.
