Procedures for Submitting & Processing Resolutions

Resolutions to make changes to the BC School Sports Constitution, By – Laws, and Policies under the new BCSS Governance structure must be submitted through your <u>BCSS Zone</u>. The Zone is required to ensure that the majority of the member schools in your zone are in support of the motion. Motions will be discussed and voted on by the Legislative Assembly at the APM on November 14 & 15, 2022.

Resolutions are due to the BCSS office no later than 4pm on October 7, 2022.

School Based Championship Hosting

Why should my school host a championship?

Provincial Championships are the most anticipated and sought-after events for any studentathlete. The memories and experiences that are gained during a provincial championship is unlike any other school sport event. Host schools receive an automatic berth to the championship, being able to provide a once in a lifetime opportunity for their students to compete and perhaps even win a provincial title at their own school while rallying the studybody and staff to support the athletics program. Additionally, working with BCSS and local sponsors, it may provide some school the opportunity to make a modest profit to support their athletics program. Lastly, there are significant savings to host schools in the form of travel and accommodation costs.

Who can host?

Any member school in good standing, in the appropriate tier, with the required facilities may host a provincial championship. School based championships will be open to all schools across the province.

How does a school become a host?

Championships will be awarded to schools that show interest and demonstrate the infrastructure and community support necessary to successfully host a provincial championship. We encourage schools that have hosted championships in the past as well as school that haven't hosted in the past. Schools can submit a bid package to Host a BCSS Championship Form and submit it to BCSS staff (info@bcschoolsports.ca). Bids for the Fall & Winter 2023 are due no later than **4:00pm on October 7, 2022.** Bid form can be found <u>here</u>.

How will my school be supported if we do host?

BCSS will provide resources to host schools with the most amount of support possible. Host schools will be provided an event budget, championship host committee manual outlining the expectations, tasks, and ideal committee structure, medals and banners, equipment, and assistance with all the planning of the championship. You will have a designated BCSS Staff Member who will be available to assist you to ensure your experience as a host, and the student-athletes experience is as memorable and enjoyable as possible

Thank you for your interest in hosting a BC School Sports Provincial Championship. Please review the following checklist and use it as a guide to support your application to host.

- ____ Review the Championship Hosting Handbook and sport specific hosting guidelines
- ____ Discuss with administration and necessary staff to gain support/approval for event
- ____ Find potential committee members and ensure participation
- ____ Ensure potential sport venues are available for the host weekend
- ____ Contact potential host hotels and banquet facilities to ensure availability
- ____ Complete the application form in its entirety and submit to BCSS
- ____ Prepare and submit your bid. (NOTE: a maximum 4-minute video may be required if more than one bid is received for a championship)
