Eligibility

The BCSSGFHC Scholarship Committee will consider candidates who meet all of the following Criteria:

1. Are in a B.C. School who are graduating this year.
2. Are entering their first year of full-time studies in a Canadian University or College.
3. Have demonstrated exceptional athletic achievement in Girl's Field Hockey.
4. Have a minimum average percentage of 75%.
5. Have demonstrated outstanding service and leadership in school and or community.

6. Fulfill the requirements of the application document.
7. Must have competed in Girl's Field Hockey at school in their Grade 12 year.

Getting Started

- Before you start your application ensure that you meet all the eligibility criteria

- Incomplete application forms will not be accepted or considered.
- Faxed applications will not be accepted.

Completing the Application

Candidates are responsible for ensuring that ALL application forms are completed electronically (*electronic form can be found on our website at www.bcschoolsports.ca*). Hand-written material (excluding signatures on the Candidates Declaration Form) will not be accepted. All attachments should be in PDF or .doc (Word) format. Other file formats will not be accepted. All documents should have the candidate's first and last name in the file name.

- Please do not reformat any part of the application form.
- Transcripts for Grade 11-12 courses (include term or semester marks)
- List of athletic achievements in Grades 10 through 12
- List of service in school/community (list only volunteer service that you did not receive remuneration for)
- List of leadership and service positions.
- Principal's signature required to validate application and supporting information.

Attachments: (Check list - Please ensure that you have attached the following to your application form)

300-500 word essay written by the student (2 typed pages maximum), including:

- Description of your leadership and community service involvement
- Future plans (scholastically and career, include University and Course)
- Your thoughts regarding the value of school athletics in your life

Two Letters of Reference

- At least one letter of reference must be from a school representative (teacher, coach, counsellor, or administrator.)
- Each letter should be a maximum of 1 page (only 2 letters will be read by the Selection Committee)
- Reference letters may be e-mailed separately from the application. The applicant's name must be used as the document name.
