BC SCHOOL SPORTS 2019 - 2020 RE-ZONING GUIDELINES

This past week, the BCSS office published the guidelines to assist our members, local athletic associations and BCSS Sport Commissions in their preparations for the upcoming change to 9 provincial zones. For those unaware, BCSS is moving to 9 zones from our current 7 zone alignment, effective September 2019. This will have an effect on local play qualifying into zones, zone championships and provincial championships. The guidelines make it clear as to what cannot be changed by a zone or a commission, and those things that are the responsibility of the zone or commission to decide.

The document is large, but don't be intimidated. Most of the document simply contains data to support the work the various groups will do in working through the decisions to be made. I do encourage everyone to read the first section of the guidelines document to understand the various changes that are coming, and also to reach out to those within your local association to take part in the discussions moving forward.
