BCSS AWARDS

Do you know someone in your school community who should be honoured for their service and dedication to your school athletic program. Nominate them today for one of the following BCSS Awards. Awards will be presented the Awards dinner at the AGM in May.

#### **Honour Award**

The Honour Award is the highest form of distinction BCSS can bestow upon an individual. This award is presented to a teacher or administrator who has demonstrated prolonged and distinguished service to school sport, at the school level in serving on the Board or one of its committees.

#### **Merit Award**

The Merit Award is presented to individuals recognizing their outstanding service to a local association or a BCSS sport in recognition of a long – standing service as a coach, supporter, administrator, or official at the school level.

#### Coach of the Year (Male & Female)

The Coach of the Year Award is to recognize the outstanding achievements of a coach. The recipient of this award guides their athletes to success in sport through their philosophy of fair play and sportsmanship. This coach leads by example and consistently demonstrates a dedication to lifelong learning and continuous improvement.

#### **Outstanding School Award**

The purpose of the Outstanding School Award is to recognize a school whose special commitment to improving the lives of its students and staff through athletics, leadership, and public service has contributed significantly to the welfare of school athletics in its local community and to BCSS.

### **TIERING NUMBERS**

The 2022 – 2023 School Year Tiering Numbers have been published on the BCSS website can be viewed <u>here</u>. Tiering numbers are determined using the September 30th, 2021 1701 numbers as submitted to the Ministry of Education.

In the fall, should a school see a material change in their enrollment from 2021 – 2022 numbers in the report, the school can file an appeal to have their numbers re-evaluated. A school can submit this anytime between September 20th, 2022, and October 1st, 2022. This is generally done when there is a significant population reduction (greater than 5%), or because of a change of school configuration (addition or removal of a grade) or new school boundaries due to a school opening or closure in the district. Tiering appeal forms can be requested by contacting the BCSS office staff.

#### Teams playing in a different tier in a specific sport

Schools wishing to play in a different tier in a specific sport must submit a tiering classification form. Forms can be requested by contacting the BCSS office staff. A separate form must be submitted for each sport a minimum of seven (7) days before the team registration deadline as outlined on the form.

#### **Boys Basketball**

Boys' basketball functions on a 2 – year tiering cycle therefore, approved requests, will be for the 2022-23 and 2023-24 seasons. Schools wishing to play in a different tier for boys' basketball will need to submit a tiering classification form no later than **April 11, 2022.** Form can be requested by contacting the BCSS office staff.

#### Hosting or Travelling to An Event

Competition between two or more BCSS member school is automatically sanctioned. When you are travelling to or hosting an event with an out of province team sanctioning is required.

Complete the <u>Hosting</u> and/or <u>Travelling</u> sanctioning forms on the website **at least 30 days in advance** of the event or fines will apply.

### GIRLS RUGBY & RUGBY 7'S

At our 2021 AGM, membership passed the addition of Girls Rugby 15's as a sanctioned BCSS activity. With this addition, schools with girls' rugby teams will now be required to add their teams and rosters to STARS.

Rugby 7's for both girls and boys has been added as a demonstration sport this year. Student-athletes will need to be added to the appropriate STARS rosters for Rugby 7's. In an effort to support schools figuring out which discipline (or both) they want to play, students may play both Rugby 7's and Rugby 15's up until the April 20, 2022 roster registration deadline. As of that date, student-athletes will only be permitted to play on one of the teams for the duration of the season. A few schools may choose to offer both 7's and 15's. After the deadline, a student cannot move from one to the other, so schools must be sure that their rosters are correct.
