

Concussion Mandate Training Reminder CATT Course Certification

We have had a great first semester of the Concussion Awareness Training Tool course with over 1,300 coaches from around the province complete the mandated CATT training. Reminder to all coaches, administrators, and athletic directors that it is mandatory for all coaching staff, and team personnel to complete the CATT training course <u>before</u> having any interaction or practices with your school teams. Schools are encouraged to keep an internal database of completed coach certificates as BCSS could ask for proof of completion at any time.
