STARS Registration

Rosters will be verified against the BCSS Student-Athlete Registration System (STARS). All coaches must also be included in the system. Event credentials will not be issued unless the coach is in STARS and listed as a coach. If team staff needs to be added, school Athletic Directors can do this for coaches with no late penalties.

Additional Details

Structure & Official Rules: Two competition formats are offered at the championships: All-Mountain (XC) and Enduro. All competitors must start in both events to earn event points. The championship event will consist of timed heats in the 'All-Mountain' event, and timed stages with staggered starts for the 'Enduro' event. Finishers will be awarded points based on their placement in each event. *Course and race map to be provided in bulletin #3.*

All-Mountain (XC)- Is an endurance event on a challenging course which can include double-track, and single-track trails, climbing, descending, traverses and passing opportunities.

Enduro- Is a timed event which the racer's finishing position is based on timed downhill stages, combined between untimed transfer sections. The overall time of the racer is not considered, instead only the timed enduro stages are used for determining finishing order.

Protests: All protests must be reported by the coach to the Race Director, in writing, within 30 minutes of the race heat finish. Any protests will be investigated by the Race Director and may result in disqualification or time adjustments.

Discrepancies: Any discrepancies in placing and scoring should be reported to the Race Director immediately. The Race Director will communicate with timing and scoring before any results can be changed.

Meals & Snacks: Food options at Red Mountain and in Rossland are extremely limited this time of year. Red Mountain Resorts is offering a pre-purchased on-hill food menu for the event. Teams are asked to pre-order all athletes, coaches, and parents' food in advance so the mountain can pre-plan for the event.
