2018 - 2019 Middle/Junior Student "Playing Up" Form



32.3.0 Middle/Junior member school athletes whose feeder school (senior school) **has a Membership Category of five (5) or higher can** "play up" to the senior member school that they would normally attend if, by the registration date (see Section 27.3.0), they have approval of both member schools' coaches, and parent(s) or legal guardian(s). The local athletic association, the district superintendent and BCSS must be notified using the Middle/Junior School, who is a member in good standing. Senior member schools must not be registering these student-athletes in STARS as part of their school. BCSS will place the middle/junior school student-athletes on the senior member school's STARS team roster when the form is received and approved. Any student-athletes not properly registered will be deemed ineligible (see Section 32.3.0 Definitions for "Playing Up" and "Moving Up").

32.3.1 Limits to Playing/Moving Up: student-athletes attending a middle school or junior secondary school cannot "play/move up" in the sports of gymnastics, mountain biking, wrestling, skiing/snowboarding, aquatics, track & field, or cross country as the minimum number to form a school team in these sports is one (1) athlete.
