THE FUTURE OF BCSS GAMING FUNDING

You may be aware that BCSS does not receive any core operating funding from the provincial government. We do, however, submit a detailed annual grant application to receive gaming funds. For the last number of year, BCSS has received \$200,000 from the Gaming Branch. Of this, nearly 70% goes to either support commissions, championships, or insurance. The rest goes into the delivery of other BCSS programs. In this year's funding letter we were notified by gaming that due to our governance structure, our gaming funding in future years could be in jeopardy. As you can imagine this is quite alarming, as it is a significant source of revenue for our organization.

BCSS is drafting a detailed memo so that the membership is fully aware of the concerns as well as the actions the Board and staff are taking on this matter. We are hoping this development is a result of some new staff in the Gaming Branch, and that with some education and communication, we can expect to continue to receive the funding. However, depending on the outcome of these decisions, it may necessitate some changes in governance. We will keep the membership updated as we look for clarity from the staff at the Gaming Branch.

Award Criteria:

- Nominees are to be nominated for and will be judged on the three seasons on play (Fall, Winter, Spring)
- An athlete can be nominated in only one Sport BC Awards category and only by a BCSS member school of member of Sport BC
- Each school can only nominate one male and one female athlete

Submission Requirements

- Submit four photos of the athlete in HD quality
- Supporting documentation is encourages (news articles)

PROVINCIAL CHAMPIONSHIP TRAVEL GRANT

BCSS as a service to our member schools works with ViaSport to provide the reporting information required for the Sport on the Move grant. This provides our schools access to over \$120,000 in funding for teams traveling over a certain distance to a BCSS Provincial Championship. What is required? All you have to do is opt-in! In the coming days, the Athletic Director at each member school will receive a notification from ViaSport. The email will ask you to opt-in to ViaSport's Sport on the Move Travel Grant. Funding is sent out to those schools that qualify after each season of play. If you do not opt-in, your school will not have the opportunity to receive funding.
