The 2022-2023 school year saw school participation numbers at a 10-year high with over 117,000 student-athlete registrations across the 19 BCSS activities and we hope 2023-2024 will see the same or even greater participation.

One area we are prioritizing is the support and development of Athletic Directors, to this extent we have developed a series of short videos to assist Athletic Directors in their roles. The videos, now on our YouTube channel serve as a resource guide throughout the school year. DEADLINE FOR ADDING COACHES TO ROSTERS

Coaches can only be added to STARS roster until the **October 18th** roster registration deadline for the applicable season of play. Schools wanting to add coaches after the deadline will need to request that BCSS staff make the addition for them. BCSS will only add coaches with confirmed CATT certification.

SANCTIONING

HOSTING OR TRAVELLING TO AN EVENT

Competition between two or more BCSS member schools is automatically sanctioned. When you are travelling to or hosting an event with an out-of-province team sanctioning is required.

Complete the **Hosting** and/or **Travelling** sanctioning forms on the website at least 30 days in advance of the event or fines will apply.

THIRD-PARTY EVENT SANCTIONING

If your school wishes to attend an event that is not hosted by a member school (e.g. university, club, community, etc.) please ensure the event has been sanctioned by BCSS before attending.

An approved list of BCSS third party sanctioned events can be found on the BCSS website here. Participation in a non-sanctioned event may lead to disqualification for post-season play.

MANDATORY COACHES **CONCUSSION TRAINING (CATT)**



A friendly reminder that all coaches, managers, and assistants must complete the Concussion Awareness Training Tool (CATT). BCSS has mandated this free training for all staff who work in youth sport. Access the course at cattonline.com. BCSS staff have conducted an audit of coaches that have completed the CATT training relative to coaches that have been added to rosters in STARS and noted that several coaches don't have the required CATT certification. BCSS will be monitoring this throughout the school year and coaches that don't have the required CATT will be deemed ineligible to coach until the training has been completed and verification sent to BCSS.

APM RESOLUTIONS

The BC School Sports Annual Planning Meeting will take place on November 9 and 10, 2023.

Resolutions to make changes to the BC School Sports Constitution, By-laws, Operating Policies and Procedures or Competitive Rules and Regulations, must be received in the BCSS office by October 5, 2023.

Only pre-circulated resolutions will be dealt with at the AGM. Resolutions will not be accepted from the floor.

Resolutions can be submitted by a BCSS Zone, BCSS Policy Committee Chair, BCSS Partner Organization, or the BCSS Board of Directors.

Resolutions will be emailed out and published to the BCSS website 21 days prior to the APM.

ACCOUNTING

All invoices will be sent by email via Quickbooks from quickbooks@notification. <u>intuit.com</u>. Please add this email address to your safe sender list. Payments can be made through EFTs or by cheque payable to BC School Sports. Unfortunately, we do not accept credit card payments.

If paying by EFT, please ensure a remittance notification is emailed to accounting@ bcschoolsports.ca to ensure your account is credited to your school. Please include our invoice number on your remittance notification.

TIERING APPEALS

If a school has seen a material change in their enrollment from 2022-2023 to their actual enrollment in 2023-2024, the school can file an appeal to have their numbers re-evaluated. A school can submit this anytime between September 20, 2023 and October 1, 2023, when there is a significant population reduction (greater than 5%), or because of a change of school configuration (addition or removal of a grade), or new school boundaries due to a school opening or closure in the district. Tiering appeal forms can be requested by contacting the BCSS office staff.

PLAYING UP A TIER IN A SPECIFIC SPORT

Schools will still have the option to play up in a specific sport by submitting a playing up form which can be requested through the BCSS office.



SPORT ON THE MOVE GRANT - OPT IN

The Province of British Columbia, through the Ministry of Tourism, Arts, Culture and Sport, is a proud supporter of amateur sport across the province. The Sport on the Move travel grant provides financial assistance to schools and students to offset the costs associated with travel to BC School Sports Championships. To become eligible to receive available Sport on the Move funds, schools must opt-in to the program each year. The opt-in window for the 2023-24 school year is October 2 to November 17, 2023.

BC School Sports will submit grant requests on behalf of all schools that participated in BCSS Provincial Championships. Only those schools that completed the opt-in with Viasport for the 2023-24 school year will be eligible to receive this funding.

Eligible schools are those that have opted-in and either traveled 350 km or more (one way), and/or taken a ferry to travel to their respective BC School Sports Senior Provincial Championship. While exact amounts are difficult to predict, awarded grants generally vary between \$0.70-\$0.85/km (one way, dependent on demand), plus additional funding if ferry travel is required or group size exceeds 5 athletes. Awarded amounts will be transferred to schools via direct deposit, 6-8 weeks after seasonal championships conclude.

CROSS COUNTRY



The 2023 Cross Country Provincial Championship will be contested for the first time as a tiered event. Moving to a 3-tiered championship provides 'A' and 'AA' schools a direct chance to qualify against other like-sized schools. In the past, smaller schools were at a severe disadvantage, as they were competing against schools that had much larger enrollment numbers. At the 2022 championships only 4 of the 60 qualifying teams were single A schools. This new structure will increase the number of runners that can qualify for provincials. We encourage all schools to begin Cross Country programs.

E-SPORTS

BCSS is no longer continuing its trial of e-sports. PlayVS will continue to offer e-sports opportunities for schools. Registration of teams and invoicing will be handled directly through PlayVS. Inquiries should be directed to eric.sutor@playvs.com.
