4. COVID PROTOCOLS

No Warm-up or warm-up/cool down lanes throughout the meet

Other than being marshalled to the blocks, racing, or using the bathrooms, swimmers must remain outside of the facilty in order to keep the building under capacity.

Masks are required to be always worn indoors except when racing

- Baskets and sanitizer provided for each lane
- Only 1 adult volunteer timer per lane (no students)
- No refreshments or food for coaches
- Refreshments and pre-packaged food for volunteer timers and officials only
- A maximum of 300 people is allowed inside Watermania at any one time, so teams are being asked to setup up tents outside in order to accommodate their rules and a COVID Marshall will be on hand to enforce their rules.
- No parents or other spectators allowed but we are trying to live stream this event

- Vaccination cards will not be required for any swimmer, coach, official, or volunteer.
- Anyone, coaches, swimmers or volunteers who do not follow the covid protocoals for this meet will be removed from the building. Swimmers who break the protocols will be scratched from the meet.

5. CLASSIFICATION OF COMPETITORS AND RULES

6. MEET RULES

- 5.1 Swim meet rules governing the meet will be SNC and SWIM BC rules.
- 5.2 No "NT (No time)" entries will be allowed for seeding purposes. All swimmers must be entered with entry time, or the entries will not be accepted. The meet secretary will not contact coaches who enter swimmers with no times.
- 5.3 The meet will run card less. Coaches are responsible for getting swimmers to the blocks. Swimmers who miss their event will not be allowed to re-swim the event.
- 5.4 The no false start rule will be in effect.
- 5.5 Swimmer's age must be included on the entry grids.
- 5.6 Once the meet is seeded, scratches will be taken, but the meet will not be reseeded.
- Maximum 4 entries per swimmer whether individual events or relays.
- 5.7 Scratches must be submitted by email no later than <u>OCTOBER 26, 2021 (see</u> <u>below)</u>

7. TEACHER SPONSOR

Each team must be accompanied at all times by a teacher sponsor. This requirement may be fulfilled by the principal of a school sending a letter with another team, designating a teacher from within the same school district as sponsor/chaperone. No teacher/no letter=no swimming.

8. REGISTRATION

It is the responsibility of coaches to ensure that their school is registered with BC School Sports and that each athlete is eligible form competition.

9. ENTRY FEES

12 \$ for each indidual swimmer

10. SCRATCHES/DECK ENTRIES

Before the meet begins, coaches must inform the clerk of the course of any scratched swimmers. Deck entries and changes are not permitted.

11. ENTRY INSTRUCTIONS

- Please download the software and familiarize yourself with the entries early to alleviate stress at the last minute before the deadline.

Entry Deadline: Friday October 22, 2021 at 4:00pm Late entries will not be accepted.

- A psych sheet and fee report will be circulated via e-mail October 25 at 5:00 pm
- Corrections need to come in an email Emails to bchsswim@gmail.com prior to October 24 at 12:00pm (to Rob)

Changes after the correction deadline need to be submitted on paper the morning of the meet, in the format of: ADD... SCRATCH... RELAY NAME, with accompanying event, swimmer name and team name. Provincial scratches must be made by November 5 at 4:00 pm
