Additional Details

Registration:

Zone executives will submit a list of qualifying athletes to BC School Sports. BCSS will then invoice each school for the relevant entry fees.

Berthing:

Each zone will be granted a minimum of 3 team berths (for each category; boys skiing, girls skiing, boys snowboarding, girls snowboarding) Zones with no registered racers will have their berths redistributed to the zone(s) with the highest registration. Additionally, for every team berth awarded an individual berth is awarded for the highest zone finishers who have not qualified as a part of a team.

Unused berths will not be backfilled.

A ski team will have a minimum of 3 racers and maximum of 6. Different athletes (teams) may be used for the giant slalom and terrain giant slalom events.
