## **ENTRY FEES**

## Entry Fee: \$350.00 (payable to BCSGA)

The entry fee covers the banquet for the five players and one coach. Additional banquet tickets are \$30 each. If you have an additional coach coming to the banquet, add \$30 to the BCSGA cheque.

## Green Fee: \$596.00 (payable to Squamish Golf Club)

This covers the green fees for the five players and one coach for all three days — that is for up to seventeen rounds of golf. Schools that have a second coach playing, must pay an additional \$40 per round. Please make this cheque payable to **Squamish Golf Club. Please include any additional green fees on the same cheque. Coaches will not be playing during the Wednesday shot gun.** 

\* The cost of green fees have been offset by a credit of \$84.00 for each school from B.C. Lotteries through B.C. School Sports.

	coaches + 7 spots). Do not ask them for 2 tee times. They want to know the exact "number of
	bodies" so they can be sure every group goes off as a foursome and everyone gets a chance to
	play.
	It may also mean you might have one or two people from other school joining you, so please make your players aware. The shotgun start will enable everyone to finish in time for the SKILLS COMPETITION which will start at 6:00pm. Teams that have a second coach playing in the practice round or in the first day draw will be charged \$40.00 per round. Cheques are payable to Squamish Golf Club. The players MUST be off the course by 5:45pm so that they can compete in the Skills

Please note: If you are planning to get to Squamish and play in an additional practice round on the Sunday, be sure to contact the pro-shop at the above number well in advance to see if they can accommodate you.

• The dress code and no tobacco code as outlined in our constitution will be in effect during the practice round and both competitive rounds. The executive will instruct the pro to forbid play to any team member who fails to comply. The dress code will be strictly enforced for the duration of the Tournament. Any player failing to comply with section XII of the Rules and Regulations will not be permitted on the course. (One notable exception to this will be, player may substitute an alternate, acceptable golf shirt, for practice rounds only, as the proper shirt will be required at dinner and the two competitive rounds.)

The golf course is charging **\$40.00** per person per round, coaches included, to offset a portion of the revenue they will lose over the three days we are there.

The banquet will be held at 7:15pm at the Squamish Golf Club. All teams **MUST** be in attendance and in the **school golf uniform**.

## **BANQUET INFORMATION**

**Placard** seating your team will be located on the tables indicating where each team is to sit. **WE MUST KNOW THE EXACT NUMBER OF PEOPLE** in your party so we can set the placards out so your team can sit together. Please tell your players to sit only where their placards indicate.

Each school will be allotted 6 places at dinner – if you have more than that number i.e. assistance coach or parent/driver, you must inform Bob Matlock ASAP preferably before he leaves for the Championship if that person wish es to join their team for dinner, other wise they cannot be accommodated in the seating. ## OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Please ensure your golfers use only the practice facilities designated by the host pro. (check with him for any restrictions.)

 Your executive along with Tournament Chair, Tina Fox, have worked hard to provide for you and your team, and we cannot stress enough the importance that all competitors maintain the high caliber of conduct and sportsmanship this association expects.

- We will have BCGA Referees on the course to assist your players with rulings. We are going to be closely monitoring the Pace of Play at this event.
- Please inform your players that they are not allowed to use power cards at any time.
- The members of your team are expected to be knowledgeable of, and comply with, the rules of the game. We have had to disqualify players and school is the past years for breaches of those rules.

In the event that a player is in doubt of a ruling and a Tournament Rules Referee is not readily available, the player must proceed as follows:

- Complete the hole with two balls
- Before making another stroke, announce to their marker or fellow competitor that he/she
  intends to play another ball and which ball they want to score
- The player **MUST** inform a Rules Referee before returning the scorecard. The penalty for not reporting facts to Tournament Rules Referee is **DISQUALIFICATION**.

## \*\*\*\*\*\* IT MUST BE DONE IN EXACTLY THIS ORDER \*\*\*\*\*\*\*

Please note that the dress code will be strictly enforced for the duration of the Championship, with the exception of the practice round on Monday where an alternate golf shirt may be worn. NO PLAYER WILL BE ALLOWED TO TEE OFF WHO FAILS TO COMPLY WITH SECTION XII OF THE RULES AND REGULATIONS RELATING TO ACCEPTABLE DRESS, AND ALL COMPETITORS ARE TO DRESS IN THEIR TEAM UNIFORMS FOR THE OPENING BANQUET MONDAY EVENING.

We have been asked by the Director of Golf at the course that as a courtesy to the Golf Club and its members, to please inform your players they are to **remove their hats at the banquet.** 

One final note for Monday, regardless of whether you play a practice round on that day or not, or where you are on the course, your team must be in attendance for the 6:00pm Skills Competition, and the 7:15pm banquet.
