The 53<sup>rd</sup> BCSS Annual General Meeting was held on Saturday May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021. 295 member schools of 375 eligible voters (78.6%) cast a ballot. It is important to note that a school could abstain from any particular motion, while still submitting a ballot, so the numbers on each motion may differ slightly.

The special resolution on the new governance structure required a 2/3 majority of the votes cast on that motion to be in favour of the motion for it to be carried, abstentions are not counted as votes cast. The ordinary resolutions required a simple majority to be carried. Due to the nature of the virtual meeting, and the significance of the special resolution BCSS used a secure voting platform for both advanced and in person voting, below is a summary of the certified results.

## Certified Results of the BCSS Motions

The Special Resolution on the new governance proposal was carried by a vote count of 212 to 77 (73.4%). The other ordinary resolutions were all carried by considerable margins.
