- A written submission of up to two pages, describing the applicant's sport, school and community involvement with a focus on demonstrated leadership, volunteerism and/or work experience. Please comment as well on the chosen program of post-secondary studies and career aspirations.
- A one-page (maximum) letter of support from a current coach indicating the applicant's character, basketball ability, and involvement in other school programs.
- A one-page (maximum) letter of support from a school administrator or teacher certifying the applicant's scholastic ability, character, and school citizenship.
- An additional letter of support (maximum of one) may be included from another reference, including a member of the community. This is not mandatory.
- An official school transcript of the Grade 11 year and the first term or interim transcript for the Grade 12 year.

Applications are evaluated by a selection committee. The committee members rank order the athletes based on demonstrated commitment and excellence in the following areas:

- 1. Basketball Accomplishments
- 2. Academic Achievement
- 3. Leadership Skills
- 4. Community Involvement
