#### 4. Gaming Grant Information

- o Jordan Abney spoke as to how the Gaming Grants are determined
  - BCSS Budget allocates as much money to the commissions as possible
  - Semi-Scientific approach to grants this year
    - Took last year's grant amount and reduced by 20% and the number of athletes in each sport and determined a hybrid amount in-between these two numbers

#### 5. Payment of Board/Executive Members

- Due to government ruling
  - You cannot get paid for sitting on the board/in a board position
  - Tournament Chairs can be given an honoraria if it is for a specific role at the event
  - Payments must be disclosed in the financial statements due to the new societies act

#### 6. Eligible Expenses for Gaming Funds

- o Facility, Officials and Equipment
  - Must be paid to the vendor directly

#### 7. Support for possible future alignment of zones with the BC Games Society

- o BC Games has 8 zones and BCSS has 7 zones
- Every other PSO/MSO uses these zones, should we align?
- o Good future discussion point

#### 8. BCSS Services and Partnerships

- BCSS is working with Sports Canada TV again this year
- o Commissions eligible for up to \$250 per location for either webcasting or medical not both
